**Where do we at All Saints Go from the 19<sup>th</sup> July?**

In a period when the COVID “Delta” variant is on an increase and the Government are removing restrictions? The Church is in a difficult position!

Some people will want to embrace the freedom that the removal of restriction laws will allow, others will want to proceed cautiously.

**The PCC are Suggesting the following at All Saints Dulverton.**

- Singing for everyone will resume.
- Those people who wish to continue to wear masks will be able to do so.
- All people entering the Church should wear a mask and then continue to or remove it when seated.
- **I suggest that we keep one side of the church for people who wish to be cautious and distance and keep masks, using the Central North and North Aisles.**
- **Those people wishing to remove masks can sit on the Central South and South Aisles and sit as they wish with others that will be happy with that arrangement.**
- The sanitizer and Masks will be available as always.
- The church will be ventilated with the doors open for the first month.
- An in the service collection or offering will now resume.
- The church will open daily from 25<sup>th</sup> July between 10.a.m.- 5.00p.m. (approx.) for visitors, private prayer etc. The track and trace system will still run with the Q code and log in book.
- On-line Services will continue as now. And are available for special events.
- Both Toilets will be open.
- Coffee after service will resume in August and served from behind screens. And tables and small groups will be the way we consume hospitality, inside or outside.

**As regards the taking of Communion:**

Communion will be offered and can be taken in either one form or both forms, but a **common cup will not be used directly. And will be taken, for the choir in front of the Altar and for the congregation in front of the Rood Screen. You will be instructed when to leave your seats by the Wardens or sidesmen.**

The way the communion will be share in **both kinds** (bread and wine) will be **“Simultaneous administration”**. That is to say:- the bread and wine will be consecrated by the priest with the wine in a Chalice (common cup). When offered to the congregation the priest will dip the wafer into the chalice so that the wine is slightly absorbed (intincted) into the wafer. The intincted wafer will then be placed in the communicants’ hand and eaten.

Hand sanitiser will be available on the way to receive communion and on return to your seat.

A **one -way system** will be used for participants to leave their pew receive the sacraments and return via another way.

If individuals wish to continue to receive communion **in one form only**(bread/wafer) you should bring your **service sheets** with you.

If a  **blessing only** is wanted you should bring your **hymn book** with you

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**In order to proceed We Will need:-**

- Ω A volunteer rota for church opening and closing
- Ω A volunteer rota for Church Coffee and hospitality.
- Ω The return of sides persons for meeting and greeting, supervising the seating and the provision of books service sheets etc.

**As regards Opening and Closing The following is already in Place. Please volunteer for the vacant slots.**

**Open** the church via the Back Door, Open the main door on the South Side.

Turn on the back lights and rood screen lights, leave the church. **(Backdoor Key Needed)**

**Closing** Enter church via South Door, check no one is in the building, Bolt the South Door, put pin in West Door, Switch off lights apart from the red Sanctuary light above the altar. Press the timer switch to put outside lights on. Leave the Church via the backdoor ensuring the yale latch is down.

**Coffee preparation and serving Rota (PTO)**

**Coffee/Tea rota:**

**Check ingredients are present: tea, Coffee, Sugar, Milk, Biscuits.**

**Pour coffee, tea, at end of service, wash up using dishwasher, put away crockery, take tea towels home to launder. Bring back to church following week.**

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
